<u>Background:</u> At the January 24, 2019 Board Meeting, a motion was made and seconded to approve the MS Youth Risk Survey without Question #10

If it is approved, the Board moves on. If defeated, the Board may entertain a new motion on the question that should look different (i.e., perhaps removing some additional questions, or putting back some of the removed questions, etc.).
